## PROCESSIONAL HYMN.

5 He shall receive the blessing from the *Lord*: and righteousness from the god of his *salva*tion.

6 This is the generation of them that seek him; even of them that seek thy face, O Jacob.

7 Lift up your heads, O ye gates; and be ye lift up, ye ever-lasting doors; and the king of glory shall come in.

8 Who is the 'King of glory? It is the Lord strong and mighty, even the Lord 'mighty in battle.

9 Lift up your heads, O ye gates: and be ye lift up, ye ever-lasting doors: and the King of glory shall come in.

10 Who is the King of glory? Even the LORD of hosts, he is the King of glory.

# Psalm i. Beatus vir, qui non abiit.

BLESSED is the man that hath not walked in the counsel of the ungodly, nor stood in the way of sinners: and hath not sat in the seat of the scornful.

2 But his delight is in the law of the Lord; and in his law will he exercise him self day and night.

3 And he shall be like a tree planted by the water-side: that will bring forth his fruit in due season.

4 His leaf also shall not wither: and look, whatsoever he doeth it shall *pros*per.

5 As for the ungodly, it is not so with them: but they are like the chaff, which the wind scattereth away from the face of the earth.

6 Therefore the ungodly shall not be able to stand in the judgment: neither the sinners in the congregation of the righteous.

5 He that sweareth unto his neighbor, and disap pointeth him not, though it were his own hindrance.

6 He that hath not given his money up-on usury; nor taken reward a gainst the innocent.

7 Whoso doeth these things: shall never fall.
