DIRECTORS' REPORT.

THE third year in the history of All Saints' Hospital shows an encouraging increase in the number of patients received. Indeed, during the greater part of the year the building has been taxed to its full capacity, and great need felt for more room. The total number of patients treated has been 394, an increase of 77 over the second year, and of 188 over the first. The total number of days of treatment has been 8,173, an increase of 1,771 over those of last year. The actual household expenses—not including interest on mortgage, insurance, repairs, etc.—has been \$7,657.37. The expense of each patient per diem has been 93.7 cents. The number of Charity patients treated has been 54, and the number of half-pay patients 40. That is, the number of charity and half-pay has been nearly one-fourth the whole number; while the proportion between the receipts for charity work and the receipts from paying patients is about one to eleven—\$7,487.28 being received from pay of patients, and other contributions amounting to only \$647.30; while the proportionate cost of maintaining the charity patients would be \$1,444.87. Thus showing that our deficiency for the past year, shown by the item of \$300.00 for Bills Payable, is due to the treatment of Charity patients, and showing also that money contributed for charity work does indeed go to that purpose: the full-paying patients more than paying their own expenses, and uniting to contribute to the expenses of their less fortunate fellow-inmates. We ought to receive more, much more than we do, for charity work. Friends of the Hospital ought
